**John Vaughan Mayor's Letter**

Once again we have survived the winter months and seen more snow than the normal for this area. Having two significant snowfall events within a 14-day time period tested some of the City's snow removal plan. I can assure you this winter was a great learning experience and we will be making improvements to the snow removal plan.

The council will be doing the annual street assessment over the next 4 to 6 weeks to determine what areas are in need of milling and paving. We are currently checking all city streets for potholes and will schedule the pothole repair as soon as possible. The council should determine within in the next few weeks the final plan for updating the city street signs.

Another sign of spring is the annual Garden Tour scheduled for May 31<sup>st</sup>. For those of you planning on participating you may find additional information in this newsletter or on the City's web page. Another spring event is the City's annual Yard Sale Saturday June 13<sup>th</sup>. Both events are always a great way to visit with your neighbors.

## YARD WASTE IN NON-COMPOSTABLE PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED

Due to Louisville's Waste Management District resolution that became effective earlier this year, Waste Management will no longer collect yard waste that is in plastic bags. Yard waste must be in paper bags, recyclable bags (compostable plastic bags must meet ASTM D6400 standards and be securely tied) or reusable containers (trash cans). According to Louisville's Waste Management instructions, bags that fail to meet the required standards are not acceptable.

Paper Lawn and Leaf bags are available at most hardware and home improvement stores. While more stores are carrying the compostable plastic bags, it's suggested you call first to confirm the stores have them in stock.

Large yard waste items that do not fit in approved bags or containers should be tied in manageable bundles that are no longer than three-foot (3'). Loose or unbundled items will not be picked up by Waste Management.

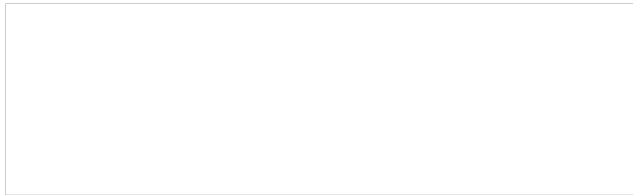
